
Our vision is to be a highly respected, transparent, and impactful organisation that honours the ANZAC legacy while helping prepare future generations of Australian leaders.

Open Access & Opportunity

- Students experiencing necessitous circumstances – such as financial, physical, familial, emotional, medical or environmental hardship.
- Regional and remote students.
- Aboriginal and Torres Strait Islander students.

Our bursaries empower students who might otherwise be excluded from pursuing their education and career goals. In this way, more descendants of our Veterans gain access to education who might not otherwise have the chance.



Build a Living Alumni Legacy

We believe that the GSF's future rests on our growing Alumni network. Our Gallipoli Scholars are our best ambassadors: they inspire new Scholars and reassure donors of the long-term impact of their support to the Veteran community. We will continue to strengthen our Alumni network and program to enable:

- Non-academic mentorship to our Scholars.
- Networking and professional development opportunities.
- Alumni-led advocacy and fundraising.
- Promoting greater community awareness of the GSF.

Our Alumni network fosters mateship, perseverance, and integrity, providing role models for future Scholars. We will continue to encourage our Scholars to become GSF members, to serve on our Management Committee, and to help promote awareness of and to develop the Fund.

Secure Sustainable Funding

We will be a respected, sustainable organisation that strives to grow its impact each year. We will continue to develop a professional, stable, and transparent funding model that ensures long-term growth. We will diversify and strengthen our funding base by:

- Strengthening and extending our partnerships with Veterans and their families, and with Veteran organisations and clubs.
- Partnering with corporate sponsors, foundations, philanthropists, and community organisations.
- Developing recurring giving programs.
- Creating new fundraising initiatives that connect donors to Scholar outcomes.

Ensure Excellence & Accountability

Integrity and respect will remain at the centre of every decision and every dollar spent. In this way we will be a resilient and future-ready organisation that earns trust and respect from our Scholars, our sponsors, our donors, and the Veteran's community. We will ensure good governance by:

- Maintaining a rigorous, fair and independent Scholar selection process.
- Providing regular reports to our donors and seeking their advice.
- Investing in digital infrastructure to streamline Scholar applications, Alumni engagement, and donor reporting.
- Building volunteer and leadership capacity, including succession planning.
- Publishing an Annual Report that transparently records the Fund's achievements and financial standing.

We will measure our success by tracking progress against our key performance indicators (KPIs):

- Number of bursaries awarded annually.
- Growth in donor base and fundraising income.
- Alumni engagement rates (mentorship, events, contributions).
- Geographic and demographic reach of recipients.
- Annual publication of impact and financial reports.


